Inpatient Services

Notification to Harvard Pilgrim is **not** required for the following inpatient services:

- **Obstetric admissions that result in delivery.**
- **Level I routine newborn care** (All non-routine care levels do need notification. See the [Non-Routine Newborn Care \(Level II-IV\)/Neonatal Intensive Care Admission Notification policy](#) for details.)

Outpatient Services

Notification to Harvard Pilgrim is **not** required for the following outpatient services:

- **Surgical day care and ambulatory/minor surgery services**
 - A physician order is required
 - Authorization is required for some procedures (For a list of surgical procedures that require authorization, refer to the [Prior Authorization Policy](#).)
- **Cardiac rehabilitation services**
 - A physician order is required
- **Early intervention (EI) service**
 - EI is a Massachusetts-only benefit
- **Nutritional counseling**
