## Our Foundation works with community to support, advocate and advance healthier lives for everyone.

In 2023, 22 Maine organizations received grants totaling \$946K+.

### **Highlights:**

- \$75,000 one-year general operating grant to Good Shepherd Food Bank to support emergency food response and food justice efforts statewide.
- \$90,000 two-year general operating grant to Maine Transgender Network, an organization strengthening mental health resources and access for transgender people and the greater LGBTQ+ community in rural northern Maine's Aroostook and Washington Counties through the Affirming Mental Health initiative.
- \$75,000 three-year general operating grant to Presente! Maine in Portland, an organization supporting displaced, Indigenous and Afro-Latine peoples of Maine through survival programs, community power building, cultural celebration and transformative healing practice.
- \$25,000 one-year general operating grant to Healthy Acadia to support the Downeast Gleaning Initiative and the Maine Senior Farm Share Program and to coordinate the Food Security Network's emergency food response efforts in Hancock and Washington counties.
- \$225,000 three-year general operating grant to Maine Initiatives in Portland, an organization connecting and engaging people around racial, social, economic and environmental justice in Maine.

In 2024, the Foundation made a new three-year \$150,000 general operating grant to Maine Women's Lobby Education Fund supporting the implementation of Maine's Paid Family and Medical Leave policy by strengthening partnerships and advancing advocacy around care work and care infrastructure. This includes community engagement, public education and strategic communication through the leadership of the Maine Paid Leave Coalition.
