Our Foundation works with community to support, advocate and advance healthier lives for everyone.

In 2023, 17 New Hampshire organizations received grants totaling \$880K. **Highlights:**

- \$25,000 one-year general operating grant to The Community Kitchen in Keene, an organization that strengthens regional food security response efforts across the Monadnock region.
- \$60,000 one-year general operating grant to Manchester NAACP to develop racial healing circle programs for teens and adults of color in New Hampshire.
- \$135,000 one-year general operating grant to New Futures in Concord to support community engagement, policy analysis and strategic communication as recent policy changes creating a statewide System of Care for Healthy Aging are implemented. Serves as lead for policy priorities developed by the New Hampshire Alliance for Healthy Aging.
- \$100,000 two-year general operating grant to New Hampshire Center for Justice & Equity, an organization that fosters connections, changes systems and meets community needs by elevating and empowering people of color in New Hampshire, including community building, organizing, policy advocacy and capacity building.
- \$120,000 three-year general operating grant to Victory Women of Vision in Manchester to support immigrant and refugee older adults and their families by embracing their cultural heritage so they can thrive as they build new lives.
