

# Diagnosis & Procedure Codes Lookup

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## Code Lookup Overview

### Introduction

The HPHConnect “Code Lookup” feature is offered as a tool, and should be used in conjunction with current coding guides, such as CPT, HCPCS, revenue codes and ICD-10-CM. The codes listed in Code Lookup do not represent Harvard Pilgrim’s billing requirements or payment policies. For more information, please refer to the Harvard Pilgrim *Provider Manual*.

### Online Code Search Options

This section describes how to perform a diagnosis or procedure code lookup. The HPHConnect Code Lookup option provides access to a full list of procedure and diagnosis codes, CPT, HCHCS, revenue codes and ICD-10-CM.

You can search for a diagnosis or procedure code online via:

- The “Office Management/Code Lookup” search option, or
- The “Search” button at the diagnosis or procedure code field on the transaction entry form

*Reminder:* When submitting Referral/Auth requests, at least one diagnosis code is required and a procedure code is required for certain service requests.

### Standard HIPAA Codes

When you do a code search, only the standard HIPAA codes display. The standard HIPAA code sets include CPT, ICD-10-CM, HCPCS and revenue codes. When submitting transactions, you must use only standard HIPAA codes.

### 4-Digit Revenue Codes

HIPAA electronic transaction coding standards require that all online authorization requests submitted with a revenue code for the requested procedure code must be submitted with a 4-digit revenue code.

For Harvard Pilgrim, this requirement primarily affects authorization requests for home care and hospice services. When submitting a home care or hospice transaction where the procedure code is a revenue code, use the appropriate 4-digit revenue code.



## Code Search Basics

- You can search by code or narrative, including synonyms and layperson terminology, with partial or complete data.
- Your search criteria must contain a minimum of three digits or characters.
- When searching for diagnosis codes with 4 or 5 digits, you must enter a decimal after the 3rd digit.
- If you enter a 4- or 5-digit diagnosis without a decimal after the 3rd digit, the search returns only diagnoses that contain the 4- or 5-digit number in the description, if any are found.
- The search results identify the code set. All diagnosis codes list ICD-10-CM. Procedure codes will indicate CPT, HCPCS, or revenue.

Reminder: Harvard Pilgrim does not accept ICD-10-CM procedure codes on referral/authorization transactions.

## Diagnosis Codes Search Results by Name

With the search type indicating "Diagnosis," enter the name of the condition in the text box and click "Find."

Example: A search for the diagnosis migraine, returns a list of diagnosis codes.

## Procedure Search by Code

With the search type indicating "Procedure," enter at least 3 digits of the code in the text box. Click "Find."

*Example:* A search for procedure codes containing "450" returns a list of HIPAA-compliant codes that match.

## Procedure Search by Name

With the search type indicating "Procedure," enter at least 3 characters in the text box. Click "Find."

*Example:* A search for procedure codes using the layperson terminology, lap chole, returns procedure codes used to report laparoscopic cholecystectomy.
